

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Apache Radio Corporation on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed by the Corporation Board of Directors that FCC rules require that a survey of the public be taken for the purpose of obtaining public comments and opinions on the Corporation's radio operations, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors recommends that a random-selected pool be taken by using every thirtieth (30th) name from the tribal rolls, as contact persons to fulfill this survey, up to fifty (50) such names, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors further requested that in the event any such 30th name is that of a minor, or of an adult who is unavailable or unwilling to participate in the survey, then, in that event, the first subsequent listed name may be used for the purposes of this survey.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of the official tribal roll for the purposes of the Apache Radio Corporation survey hereinabove described.


The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
