WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has created the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation, under the direction of the Board of Directors, and


WHEREAS, the Board has requested an addition to their budget of \$4,895.00 for travel expenses of the Board for the remainder of the current fiscal year, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that the Board must undertake extensive travel in order to successfully meet their obligations to the corporation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes and directs the expenditure addition to the Fiscal Year 80-81 Budget of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation in the amount of \$4,895.00 for the purposes hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Central Tribal Business Office is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate said amount by an amendment to the Central Tribal Fiscal Year 80-81 Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
