

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that it is required to provide a prioritized list of names of tribal members for eligibility for the Home Improvement Program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously identified and recognized the critical housing needs of Ethelyne Kessay and Eliza (Armstrong) Sanchez, respectively, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that these tribal members' housing needs be satisfied through the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs that the currently identified housing request of Ethelyne Kessay be included in the priority listing for the Home Improvement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Eliza (Armstrong) Sanchez currently on Fiscal Year 1980 Contract under Category D be moved to Category B and total costs not to exceed \$9,000.00.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution NO. 80-228 is hereby rescinded.
