RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been informed that the term of one member of the Board of Commissioner of the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority expired on July 13, 1980, and

WHEREAS, said position has been held by Mr. Ernie Crocker, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the reappointment of Mr. Crocker to the Board is in the best interest of the Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, the tenure of such office is four (4) years.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reappoints Mr. Ernie Crocker to the Board of Commissioner, White Mountain Apache Housing Authority for a term of four (4) years commencing July 13, 1980 and ending July 13, 1984.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
