

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 594), as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and to be responsible for the general welfare of its membership, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is an Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, 25, U.S.C. §467, and is federally recognized by the United States Government, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been operating Child Day Care Services for many years on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is desirous and in need of continuing to provide Child Day Care Services, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security has authorized cost reimbursable contract from July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981, to provide technical assistance for the provision of Child Day Care Services.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, to enter into a contractual agreement with the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the purpose of providing Child Day Care Services for Department of Economic Security sponsored children, and to execute any and all documents necessary to carry on these purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
