

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, problems of youth including truancy, alcohol abuse, inhalent abuse and delinquency continue to escalate, and

WHEREAS, these problems are endangering the future of said youth, and

WHEREAS, bordom and lack of facilities for the pursuit of activities that are alternatives to destructive behavior are inadequate in many reservation communities, and

WHEREAS, the Seven Mile Community is one such community.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that is hereby allocates Revenue Sharing Funds to the Seven-Mile Community for the construction of a basketball court (without lights) and a base-ball diamond in the amount of \$11,405.00.

The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
