

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mr. Labon Declay, a tribal member, has requested the assistance of the Tribal Council in obtaining his retirement from tribal employment with Fort Apache Timber Company; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Declay has informed the Tribal Council that he worked for thirty years, and suffers from physical problems which make his continued employment without retirement, very difficult for him; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Declay said that he should be eligible for retirement at this time but he has been told he is not.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Personnel Department to check into all aspects of Mr. Labon Declay's retirement eligibility, and to advise the Office of the Chairman of appropriate recommended action.


The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
