

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to apply for funds in the amount of \$4,446.00 for an Adult Education Program from the State Department of Education of Arizona, to improve educational opportunities for Indian adults by providing educational services that are not available in sufficient quantity or quality, and

WHEREAS, the communities of Whiteriver and McNary have agreed to participate in this program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal to enter into a contract with the Arizona State Department of Education, according to the guidelines of the Adult Education Division, for the purpose hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consummate this contractual agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
