


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented a list of tribal members who request specific homesite assignments; and

WHEREAS, the list of tribal members, with a description of specific locations requested is attached.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the homesite applications, as recommended by the Land Board.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

He said the area belongs to his father ever since he can remember so now it belongs to Mrs. George his sister. (Some other people will also be invited to the next meeting concerning this land.)

Mrs. Stella Walker requested the Board to keep Mr. Francis Antonio off of her farmland and to tell him to take his lock off the gate. The farmland is located at Canyon Day. Raymus told her that he will check this out. She also wants to have Mrs. Nellie Massey and Euclan Walker's name put on the farmland.
