WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented a list of tribal members who request specific farmland assignments; and

WHEREAS, the list of tribal members, with a description of specific locations requested is attached; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has also been presented with the relinquishment of certain lands to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the farmland applications, and relinquishments as recommended by the Land Board.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
