


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and informed that the Council minutes and resolutions from its November 5 & 6, 1980 meeting were not submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs within ten days from the meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to leave no doubt as to the validity of any of these items.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms its minutes and resolutions from the November 5 & 6, 1980 Regular Council Meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on November 18, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
