FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee met on November 26, 1980, and


WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee recommends to the Tribal Council the adoption of fifty-three (53) individuals pursuant to Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered each applicant on the list of fifty-three (53) submitted for consideration.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the fifty-three (53) applicants on the attached list be adopted into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
