


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented a list of tribal members who request specific farmland assignments, and

WHEREAS, the list of tribal member, with a description of specific location requested is attached.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the farmland application, as recommended by the Land Board.

The foregoing resolution was on December 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
