

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has previously acted to authorize a sixty-day (60) extension of time on the fencing of the north boundary at Rim Road, at the request of several non-Indians homeowners bordering the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, during such time the Tribe has been informed of a possible negotiated exchange of land with the Tribe which would provide access on the Rim Road to the off-reservation homeowners while granting other land to the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Raymus Albert, Land Coordinator of the Tribe, has viewed the areas under discussion in this proposed negotiation and has informed the Tribal Council about the location and other related matters, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has extensively reviewed the proposed ideas of a land exchange, which would include National Forest land, if all parties agree, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe for several appraisals of the relative land values be undertaken by the Tribe, prior to consummating any such land exchange.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs Mr. Raymus Albert, Land Coordinator for the Tribe, to obtain not less than three appraisals on the value of the land areas to be exchanged, to include a Bureau of Indian Affairs appraisal.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Albert is instructed to report his findings to the Tribal Council at the next earliest meeting at which such information is available.

The foregoing resolution was on December 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
