RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is presently in the process of applying for EPA funding of the White Mountain Apache Wastewater Management System, a centralized sewage collector system and treatment plant designed to serve the central communities of the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the grant guidelines of EPA require that the Tribe, as grantee, shall enact a Tribal Sewer Use Ordinance (with associated user charges) designed to assure the future successful operation and maintenance of the system; the said ordinance to be enacted as a pre-condition to approval of the grant, and
- WHEREAS, there is attached to this resolution, and made a part hereof by reference, a draft Sewer Use Ordinance based upon the requirements for an operating system on the White Mountain Apache Reservation; said ordinance requiring that users of the system (including commercial, industrial, educational and governmental establishments) be charged a fair and equitable fee for use of the system.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves the said draft Sewer Use Ordinance and authorizes its interim use, subject to final processing and official adoption as a Tribal Ordinance.

The foregoing resolution was on January 07, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
