

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation requires land sites assigned to it for the expressed purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating a studio, satellite earth terminal, transmitter and tower, and four translator station sites, for the express purpose of operating a radio broadcast facility and, further, said Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation requiring assignment of said land sites for the aforesaid purposes for not less than twenty-five years with right of renewal, and
- WHEREAS, the most suitable land for the proposed studio, satellite earth terminal, transmitter and tower, and four translator station sites, the description of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference in this resolution as if set out in full, is located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, within the boundaries of the State of Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is under the control of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and is governed by its Tribal Chairman and Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, no objection has been received regarding the land sites and purposes therefore, as afore described.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the land cited above is hereby assigned to the applicant/operator, Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation, with the right to construct, maintain, operate, and remove the apparatus proposed herein, for a period of not less than twenty-five years following completion with the right of renewal of said assignment.


The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

- 1) CIBECUE PEAK: A PARCEL OF LAND 200 FEET BY 200 FEET LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECTED NW $\frac{1}{4}$, OF THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$, OF SECTION 31, T7N, R19E, G&SRB&M, ON THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, ARIZONA.
- 2) CARRIZO BLUFF: A PARCEL OF LAND 200 FEET BY 200 FEET LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECTED SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 13, T7N, R19E, G&SRB&M, ON THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, ARIZONA.
- 3) SILVER BUTTE: A PARCEL OF LAND 200 FEET BY 200 FEET LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECTED NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 26, T6N, R20E, G&SRB&M, ON THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, ARIZONA.
- 4) SEVEN MILE: A PARCEL OF LAND 300 FEET BY 300 FEET LOCATED WITHIN THE -----S $\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 19, T4 $\frac{1}{2}$ N, R23E, G&SRB&M, ON THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, ARIZONA.
- 5) KINNEY MOUNTAIN: A PARCEL OF LAND 200 FEET BY 200 FEET LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECTED W $\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 24, T8N, R23E, G&SRB&M, ON THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, ARIZONA. *SEE NOTE.
- 6) SHOPPING CENTER SITE: A PARCEL OF LAND 200 FEET BY 200 FEET LOCATED WITHIN THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 14, T5N, R22E, G&SRB&M, ON THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, ARIZONA.
