RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to quality behavioral health and social services for its members, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is built upon the strengths of its component family units, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes that therapuetic counseling services to troubled Apache families will further strengthen the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Child Welfare Act, PL 95-608, Title II, provides for the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to enter into contracts with tribes for said tribes to provide such services, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorized the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute such contracts and/or any amendments, and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Chairman is to run concurrent with the term of the contract.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests from the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, a contract to provide services to families under Indian Child Welfare Act funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract is to commence in the Fiscal Year 1981 and is to be administered by the Tribal Guidance Center.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the contract and/or any amendments and to sign any and all documents to consumate this contract.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
