


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe had previously enacted Ordinance No. 117, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised and informed that Ordinance No. 117 was not delivered to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office within the ten-day requirement under the Constitution, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that said Ordinance No. 117 must be reaffirmed for good cause appearing.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ordinance No. 117 is hereby reaffirmed.

The foregoing resolution was on January 08, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
