

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Indian Agency staff discussed the Zero Base Budget for Fiscal Year 1983, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council accepted the Superintendent's proposals for the minimum (80%) level and proposed (120%) level, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council had total input of establishing priorities at the current (100%) level, and

WHEREAS, it was agreed by the Tribal Council that the improved (115%) level would be a mathematical projection of the current (100%) level.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Zero Base Budget for FY 1983 for the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby accepted as discussed.

The foregoing resolution was on January 29, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
