WHEREAS, priorities have been established for these projects.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Whte Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the priority list and will offer assistance to the Indian Health Service in obtaining funds for these projects.

The foreging resolution was on March 04, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
