

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has agreed with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority for the White Mountain Apache Tribe to install domestic water-supply and sewage-disposal facilities for Low-Rent houses, HUD AZ 16-31 in several communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the Indian Health Service to construct these water and sewage facilities for the houses in these communities has been adopted by the Housing Authority and Utility Authority, and


WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has requested an agreement by and between the Indian Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Utility Authority, such agreement having been discussed with the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribe is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the construction of domestic water-supply and sewage-disposal facilities for Indian homes in the communities throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 04, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
