RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe had established the 'Whiteriver Beautification Project" as a priority for use of Fiscal Year 1981 Tribal Government Improvement Funds in the amount of \$125,000.00 by Resolution No. 205 adopted on July 8, 1980, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that a "Guard Alarm Systems Project" and "Community Park Facilities Project" would be more beneficial to the White Mountain Apache Tribe in terms of overall Tribal Government Improvement.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves "Guard Alarm Systems Project" and "Community Park Facilities Project" for use of all Fiscal Year 1981 unobligated Tribal Government Improvement Funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 80-205 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
