RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service as agreed with the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to install domestic sewage disposal facilities for communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the Indian Health Service to assist in the design and construction of the regional sewer system for houses in and around the communities surrounding Whiteriver has been adopted by the Utility Authority, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has requested an agreement by and between the Indian Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and the White Mountain Apache Utility, such agreement having been discussed with the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribe is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the construction of domestic sewage disposal facilities for Indian homes in the communities throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h, & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
