RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs jointly operate the Whiteriver Volunteer Fire Department and the Cibecue Volunteer Fire Department, and
- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Central Office of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the non-federal employee volunteer firemen are not insured by either the Tribe or the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, this situation places these men in a position whereas no compensation would be received in case of an injury or death while fighting fires.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Administrative Office be authorized to purchase insurance to cover the Whiteriver Volunteer Fire Department and the Cibecue Volunteer Firemen for Life, Disability and Medical with Deductible of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and that the budget amount be taken from the amount for Insurance.

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
