RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by Mrs. Katherine Colelay, Theatre Manager for the Commercial Center, that Denise Quintero, as Manager for the Bowling Alley, is receiving \$16,000. annually for salary, and
- WHEREAS, Katherine Colelay alleges that she is only receiving \$12,000.00 a year salary and that she has been Theatre Manager for three (3) years, and
- WHEREAS, Katherine Colelay objects to the difference in salary between herself and Denise Quintero and the Council, based on information provided by Katherine Colelay, is of the opinion that there is no just reason for the difference in salary.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Katherine Colelay's request for a salary increase equal to that of Denise Quintero be granted and that she forthwith be paid at the rate of \$16,000.00 per year effective immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this decision is based upon allegations made by Katherine Colelay and is subject to revision pursuant to budget restraints and verification of the allegations made by Katherine Colelay.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for 0 against, 2 abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
