RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service is supporting a Tribal housing project by providing sanitation facilities for seventy (70) Tribal housing units, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service will provide additional funding in Project No. PH 80-387 to construct these facilities, and
- WHEREAS, it would be mutually advantageous to allow the White Mountain Apache Tribal Utility Authority to construct a portion of these facilities in order to relieve some of the workload from the Indian Health Service Force Account Crew which will be working full time on the Cibecue Sewer Project.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment
 Number 4 to Memorandum of Agreement for Project Number
 PH 80-387 to allow the White Mountain Apache Tribal
 Utility Authority to construct a portion of these
 facilities on a reimbursable basis, as personnel and
 equipment are available.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
