RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with a request by the White Mountain Apache Enterprise Manager to approve a tribal member land lease in the Hondah Homesite Area managed by such Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise Manager has informed the Council that the Enterprise imposes a building code on any home construction in such area, in order to maintain proper standards of development in the area, and that lots there are approximately one-half (1/2) acre in size, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the necessity for such building standards, and the request for such land lease in the Hondah Homesite Area by Mrs. Betty (Williams) Gomez, a tribal member.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a homesite lease of no less than 1/2 acre of land to Mrs. Betty (Williams) Gomez, covering Hondah Lot A-111 and approved by the White Mountain Apache Enterprise management in the Hondah Homesite Area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proper building construction requirements shall be imposed through the Enterprise on construction on such land assignments.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent are authorized and directed to take such action as is appropriate to carry out this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
