## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by the Tribal Administrative Manager that Apache Construction Company has left the reservation and taken with it, office furniture that was being used by the Apache Development Enterprise of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, Apache Development Enterprise does not have any office furniture nor does it have money on hand to purchase office furniture to replace that taken by Apache Construction Company, a private, non-tribal entity, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Administrative Manager advised the Tribal Council that \$7,500.00 is necessary to be appropriated to replace the office furniture and equipment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Administrative Manager to locate savings within the Tribal budget for the acquisition of office furniture for Apache Development Enterprise, not to exceed a budget sum of \$7,500.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Administrative Manager is directed to first exhaust other sources within the tribal government and other agencies to locate office furniture that can be utilized in lieu of purchasing new office furniture.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Tribal Administrative Manager cannot locate used, surplus or tribal office furniture for the Apache Development Enterprise, that he should contact the Bureau of Indian Affairs and request a loan of any surplus of office equipment and furniture, such as desks and chairs that they may have available.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Administrative Manager report back to the Council by letter to the Chairman as to the source of the office equipment and furniture for the Apache Development Enterprise and to further report the total sum of expenditures for said office equipment and furniture before the next Regular Tribal Council Meeting in September, 1981.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
