- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the Health Services Administration, Public Health Service, Department of Human Services, is currently searching for an individual to fill the position of Director, Indian Health Service, and
- WHEREAS, applications and recommendations of qualified individuals to be considered for this top management position have been solicited by the Personnel Operations Branch of Indian Health Service, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is of the opinion that there's no individual better suited for this top position than Dr. Blue Spruce who is presently Area Director of the Indian Health Service in Phoenix, Arizona.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends that Dr. Blue Spruce be appointed to the position of Director, Indian Health Service.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that its recommendation that Dr. Blue Spruce be appointed to the position of Director of Indian Health Service be communicated to Mr. James D. Sharlow, Chief, Personnel Operations Branch, Room 6A-33, Parklawn Building, 5600 Fishers Lane, Rockville, Maryland 20857.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
