

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by Mr. E. L. Sanchez, Principal of the Seven Mile Elementary School, that there is a great need for a Kindergarten Classroom at the Seven Mile Elementary School as evidenced by the fact that Kindergarten children are now using a supply room for a classroom, and
- WHEREAS, plans have been initiated for the installation of a 68' x 28' double-wide trailer to be placed on the present parking lot of the Seven Mile Elementary School, and
- WHEREAS, plans call for the trailer to be placed on a concrete footing with permanent plumbing installed on said parking lot, and
- WHEREAS, the land upon which the parking lot is situated was assigned on a loan basis by the Board of Directors of the Turkey Creek Livestock Association in 1974 for purposes of use as a parking lot, a copy of said resolution and diagram of the land in question attached to this resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference herein, and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to obtain the permission of Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in order to locate the trailer with concrete footing and plumbing installed on the parcel of land previously loaned to the Seven Mile Elementary School for parking purposes, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Eusebio Sanchez, Principal of the Seven Mile Elementary School has represented to the Tribal Council that he has obtained permission from the Turkey Creek Livestock Association for the location of the proposed trailer with concrete footing and plumbing on the parking lot land previously loaned to the Seven Mile Elementary School and good cause appearing for the granting of permission to so locate the trailer.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission is hereby granted to the Seven Mile Elementary School to locate a trailer, approximately 68' x 28' on concrete footing with permanent plumbing installed on the landsite now being utilized as a parking lot which was previously loaned by the Turkey Creek Livestock Association to the Seven Mile Elementary School.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this permission is subject to review and future reassignment from time to time, as provided by Tribal Ordinance or Resolution.




Dear Mr. Amos;
