RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested by the Museum of Northern Arizona University for an Antiquities Permit, Control No. 360-Ax/81-030 to engage in work on the White Mountain Apache Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, regulations set forth in 25 CFR 132.2 provide that an Antiquities Permit may be granted only after obtaining the consent of the Tribe and the concurrence of the Bureau of Indian Affairs official having immediate jurisdiction over the property, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed at length the advantages and disadvantages of granting the Antiquities Permit Application of the Museum of Northern Arizona University.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby denies the request of the Museum of Northern Arizona University for an Antiquities Permit to work on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that a copy of this resolution be delivered to the Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Phoenix.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby requested to notify the Museum of Northern Arizona University of the denial of their Antiquities Permit Application to work on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on October 20, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
