## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE EDUCTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by Thurman Susan of the Indian Health Service for permission from the Tribal Council to dig three new wells: One at Fort Apache and two at the Post Office Farm; and
- WHEREAS, after discussion, the Tribal Council concluded that tentative approval be given to the well site at Fort Apache and approval be given to the well sites at Post Office Farm.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants tentative approval to Indian Health Service to place a well at Fort Apache pending further study.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council grant approval to the Indian Health Service to place two new wells at Post Office Farm.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
