

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, 18 USC 1161 provides that an Ordinance may be duly adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribe which allows the introduction of liquor into the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the duty and responsibility of regulating the possession, use, consumption and sale of alcoholic beverages on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts the attached liquor ordinance and directs the same to be posted for a period of 10 days in accordance with the requirements of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby directed to submit this law and ordinance to the Secretary of the Interior for publication in the Federal Register in the most expedient manner.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g and q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
