RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache elk herd in the vicinity of Cibecue is currently under utilized; and
- WHEREAS, the Cibecue elk herd would not be hurt by a special hunt; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache people would benefit from the extra elk hunt.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they approve the special "any" elk hunt.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the hunt dates be set at January 9, 1982, through January 27, 1982, and that the hunt area be limited to the to the Reservation west of U.S. Highway 60.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the hunt be limited to tribal members only and that all tribal members participating in the hunt be required to pick up an elk tag from the Game and Fish Department in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1981, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
