RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN AFACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by a previous Resolution No. 81-214 passed on September 9, 1981 approved a request by KVSL for permission to place a Radio Tower on Pinetop Mountain inside the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for purposes of enhancing and improving radio reception on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Braodcasting Corporation has come before the Tribal Council to protest the placement of a tower on Pinetop Mountain by KVSL on the grounds that it will constitute great competition to the growth of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation and will seriously impair the ability of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation to obtain paid-for-advertisements, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the position of the Board of Directors for the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation is valid at this time.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 81-214 granting permission to KVSL to place a radio antenna on top of Pinetop Mountain is hereby rescinded at the request of the Board of Directors of the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Attorney Robert Brauchli is directed to personally contact Mr. Hugh Williams, General Manager of KVSL Radio to advise him of this resolution so that he will not incur additional expense in planning toward placing the antenna on Pinetop Mountain.

The foregoing resolution was on December 03, 1981 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
