RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has for several years been pursuing its primary goal of social and economic self-sufficiency; and
- WHEREAS, the three-year developmental projects outlined in the refunding application to the Administration for Native Americans for FY 1982 are consistent with this goal and with other tribal planning efforts.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to
 submit a proposal to enter into a contract with the
 Department of Health and Human Services, Administration
 for Native Americans for the period May 1, 1982, through
 April 30, 1983, and to recontract every year thereafter.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consumate a contractual agreement and subsequent recontractual agreements every year thereafter.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b, i, j, k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
