

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilman Lafe Altaha has advised the Tribal Council that a member of his district, Mrs. Bernice Malone, reported to him that her fence was destroyed by heavy equipment used by Indian Health Service in their water-line construction program; and

WHEREAS, Lafe Altaha has reported that Indian Health Service has never responded to his inquiry as to whether or not IHS will repair or donate the necessary materials to the family in order to repair the fence which is important for their pasture and farmland; and

WHEREAS, Lafe Altaha also has received a complaint from Anderson Truax of Carrizo that there is a serious water leak in his front yard because Indian Health Service improperly installed a water line for his home which still remains unrepaired.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a request is hereby made to the Indian Health Service to repair or donate the necessary materials to the Bernice Malone family in order to repair the damage to her fence committed by Indian Health Service heavy equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Indian Health Service is requested to take immediate corrective action to repair the water-line to Anderson Truax's house in Carrizo.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Indian Health Service is requested to respond to this Tribal Council request and acknowledge the same within five days of the receipt thereof by the Director of Indian Health Service Hospital, White-river, Arizona by correspondence directly with the Tribal Chairman

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (e, t, u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984


