## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT AFACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Office Director, Leroy Lupe, advised the Tribal Council that Mr. Snyder, a maintenance employee at the Tribal Housing Program, has committed improprieties, is disrespectful to tribal members and is residing in a rent-free tribal house; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Snyder is a non-tribal member and is using a house designated for tribal members only for which there exists a great shortage; and
- WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that Mr. Snyder should not be permitted to reside in a tribal house and should vacate immediately; and
- WHEREAS, it is also the opinion of the Tribal Council based on the presentation made by the TERO Director that Mr. Snyder should be removed from his position as maintenance man for the Housing Program, and good cause appearing.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that the Tribal Council Director is hereby directed
  to terminate in accordance with personnel policies of the
  White Mountain Apache Tribe, Mr. Snyder from his Tribal
  Housing Program employment and the Housing Authority
  Director is further directed to immediately remove Mr.
  Snyder from the tribal housing he occupies so that an
  eligible tribal member on the housing waiting list can
  have that home made available to him or her in accordance
  with Tribal Resolutions and policies.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
