

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe in Resolution No. 81-49 supported the jail removal initiative; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe submitted a jail removal initiative application for funding from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention to develop plans and program to remove juveniles from the Whiteriver Jail to deinstitutionalize status offenders and to implement alternatives to incarceration; and

WHEREAS, alternative buildings at Theodore Roosevelt School and the old hospital have been identified and set aside for use as a juvenile center; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention will include approximately \$23,300.00 to pay for materials and supplies to renovate the above identified building.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe hereby agrees to provide the labor cost necessary to complete the renovation of the designated building to be used as the Juvenile Center for the jail removal initiative program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Juvenile Judge, Kay Lewis, is hereby directed to complete an appraisal of the old hospital site and the Theodore Roosevelt School site within five (5) days and make a recommendation to the Tribal Council forthwith through the Tribal Chairman for the designated Juvenile Center.


The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section I (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984).
