

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe in Resolution No. 81-49 supported the jail removal initiative; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe submitted a jail removal initiative application for funding from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention to develop plans and program to remove juveniles from the Whiteriver jail, to deinstitutionalize status offenders and to implement alternatives to incarceration; and

WHEREAS, alternative buildings at Theodore Roosevelt School and the old hospital have been identified and set aside for use as a juvenile center; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's jail removal initiative program at the juvenile center will be under the direction of the Juvenile Court Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court presently operates out of the Tribal Court where space is inadequate to provide the privacy necessary to effectively deal with juveniles and their families; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient space available in the buildings identified for use as the juvenile center to house the Juvenile Court and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court staff will be better able to assist the jail removal initiative staff and the Juvenile Court Judge will be better able to supervise the program if housed in the juvenile center together.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe's juvenile center, staff, records, equipment, etc., will move into the juvenile center as soon as the renovation is complete.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judge of the Juvenile Court will determine the Court's and the jail removal initiative program needs for space in the Juvenile Center and will instruct the foreman of the renovation project accordingly.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
