RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe at a regular Council meeting on January 6 and 7, 1982, passed numerous resolutions on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, said resolutions must be signed within 10 days from the date they were passed; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Mary C. Endfield, Acting as the Secretary of the Tribal Council on January 6 and 7, 1982, has been unable to prepare said resolutions for signatures due to the passing of her beloved husband, and she has therefore, been excused from her duties; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to renew and readopt all resolutions passed on January 6 and 7, 1982.
- BE IT RESOVLED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all resolutions passed during the Tribal Council's regular meeting on January 6 and 7, 1982, are hereby renewed and readopted effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on January 19, 1982, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 26, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
