

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Seven-Mile Community Elderly Feeding Program has experienced several break-ins resulting in loss of food products and damage to the building and facilities, and


WHEREAS, the workers of the program feel that the East Fork Community Building would provide a safer atmosphere for the Elderly Feeding Program, and

WHEREAS, the East Fork Community representatives are agreeable with the proposed relocation of the Elderly Feeding Program from the Seven-Mile Community Building to the East Fork Community Building.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the ANA Office and Mrs. Delores Palmer, Director of the Elderly Feeding Program be requested to transfer the operation of the Elderly Feeding Program from the Seven-Mile Community Building to the East Fork Community Building.

The foregoing resolution was on February 05, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
