


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, representatives of the Canyon Day Livestock Association Board have come before the Tribal Council and petitioned the Tribal Council that Marcelo Minjarez, the Tribal Administrative Manager, be directed to meet with the Canyon Day Livestock Association Board in order to provide them with financial counsel and advise them and to assist them in their budgetary plans for the future in order to meet their financial needs and problems, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that there is good cause for this request and appreciates that the Livestock Association Board has come before the Tribal Council with their request for financial advice before their problems become grave and serious.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Marcelo Minjarez, Tribal Administrative Manager, is hereby requested and directed to meet; as soon as possible, with the Canyon Day Livestock Association Board for purposes of assisting them in their budget and plans to meet their particular financial needs and problems.


