

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that its contract with Attorney William H. Veeder is due to expire on April 01, 1982, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and William H. Veeder may wish to negotiate the terms of a new contract, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and William H. Veeder require sixty (60) days' time in which to meet and discuss the terms of a new contract between the Tribe and Mr. Veeder for purposes of representing the Tribe in water rights litigation, legislation and other water development areas, and

WHEREAS, Superintendent Henry Dodge has been advised that the Council wishes to extend William H. Veeder's present contract for a period of sixty (60) days for purposes of negotiating a new contract and the Superintendent concurs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends for a period of sixty (60) days for purposes of renegotiating the Attorney Contract of William H. Veeder, the present contract that exists between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and William H. Veeder pursuant to the provisions set forth therein.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the present Attorney contract with William H. Veeder extended by this resolution shall expire on June 01, 1982.

The foregoing resolution was on March 17, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a,d,f,i & u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
