

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the recent Tribal Election for the offices of Chairman, Vice-Chairman and certain councilmen positions also requires that the Tribal Council appoints a new Council Secretary to serve until the next scheduled Tribal Election, and

WHEREAS, Reno Johnson, Sr., Vice-Chairman of the Tribal Council made a presentation to the Tribal Council for the reappointment of Mrs. Mary C. Endfield as Council Secretary, and

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman recounted to the Tribal Council and to all those present, Mrs. Endfield's thirty-two (32) years of exemplary service, loyalty and sense of responsibility which she exhibited in her position as the Tribal Council Secretary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council unanimously shares the Vice-Chairman's appreciation for the extraordinary term of service that Mrs. Endfield has given to the many Tribal Councils that have been in session and to the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe since October/1949, which is the month and year in which she was first appointed to her present position as Tribal Council Secretary, and

WHEREAS, based upon unanimous acclamation of the Tribal Council, the Tribal Council reappoints Mrs. Mary C. Endfield to the position of Tribal Council Secretary.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it is with great appreciation and sincerity for a job well done for over thirty-two years that it hereby unanimously reappoints Mrs. Mary C. Endfield to the position of Tribal Council Secretary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that this resolution recognizes Mary Endfield's devotion to duty and to the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and for her valuable assistance to the many Tribal Councils that have sat before her for over thirty-two years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby sets the salary for Mrs. Mary C. Endfield at the amount of \$23,000.00 per annum with all appropriate fringe benefits and Tribal cost of living increase or step increases from time to time that may be appropriate.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Sec. 4. of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
