

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by Mrs. Rita Taylor, a tribal member and employee of the tribe, that she be considered for an increase in salary, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Taylor has worked for the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the Tribal Business Office for several years, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Taylor's title is Contract and Grants Coordinator, under general supervision, performs a variety of duties relating to controls and grants; performing related work as assigned, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council is further informed that the job responsibilities covers numerous contracts involving tribal enterprises and tribal activities that are necessary for the advance and progress of the Tribe, and


WHEREAS, presently the salary for this full-time position is \$11,035.00, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Taylor advises that due to the high cost of living and the increased responsibilities involved in her job, she is requesting that her salary be increased to \$16,000.00 per annum.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Mrs. Rita Taylor for an increase in salary as stipulated above from \$11,035.00 to \$16,000.00 per annum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the increase is immediately effective.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
