

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Marcelo Minjarez, Administrative Manager for the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested that the Tribal Council approve a six percent (6%) cost of living increase to employees of the Tribe whose budgets have not yet been approved for the 1982/1983 Fiscal Year; namely, Departments 01, 12, 13, and 14, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Administrative's request is to avoid costly supplemental payroll labor costs and Business Office time which could be avoided by allowing those persons whose department budgets have not yet been approved to receive the 6% increase excluding those employees who receive living costs plus merit increase, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Administration Office can save considerable amount of clerical cost and time by approving the request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Administrative Manager to grant the six percent (6%) cost of living increase to those employees who work in departments where 1982/1983 Budgets have not yet been approved by the Tribal Council on this date, May 19, 1982.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Administrative Manager is directed to only issue the 6% cost of living increase and not to issue any cost plus merit increases to those persons who are employed by Tribal Departments which have not yet had their budgets approved.


The foregoing resolution was on May 19, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
