

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, under the provision of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Amended Constitution and By-Laws of June 27, 1958, the Tribal Council is required to prepare and implement a formal budget for all expenditures of the Tribal financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Agriculture Enterprise (WMAAE) (Tribal Account No. 12-00) has proposed an operating budget for FY 1982-83 (copy attached), as follows:




WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache Agriculture Enterprise also proposes a capital budget of \$124,663, as follows:

One (1) Each: John Deere Windrow, #2280	22,500.00
One (1) Each: Steam Cleaner	1,600.00
One (1) Each: Air Compressor	<u>1,700.00</u>
TOTAL	\$124,663.00

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves the White Mountain Apache Agriculture Enterprise operating and capital budgets as outlined above and authorizes the expenditures in accordance with applicable Tribal and Federal regulations.

The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 2, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
