

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Federal Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), under Section 681 of the Community Services Block Grant Act of 1981, proposes to fund community economic development projects for states and Indian reservations in the amount of Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000.00) in Fiscal Year, 1982, and


WHEREAS, the guidelines for the said Community Services Block Grants (CSBG) program are designed to assist in the development of Tribal capabilities for planning and developing community programs that will serve the lower-income population and provide employment through both Tribal and individual projects, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Community Development Corporation, which was formed by Council resolution in May, 1981, will provide a means for making the CSBG program effective on-Reservation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, through the Tribal Economic Development Planner, to develop, under the CSBG guidelines, a proposal to be submitted to DHHS by June 21, 1982 for a Community Services Block Grant to fund the development of business and job-creating projects on the Reservation over the next twelve (12) months, in line with the Tribal Overall Economic Development Program (OEDP).

The foregoing resolution was on June 03, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
