RESOLUTION OF THE WILTE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation has requested from the Tribal Council a resolution approving their application for a HUD Grant in order to complete the radio station facilities, specifically, the parking area, translator enclosures, the final cabinet and shelfing work, the security system, pavement to the skill center, satellite dish and other construction necessary in Fiscal Year 1983 in order to complete the facility, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with the request and hereby gives permission to the Radio Broadcasting Corporation to make an application for HUD Grant funds for Fiscal Year 1983, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directs that the Radio Broadcasting Corporation apply for the grant through their consultant or through Don Booker, Tribal Planner in the amount of approximately \$30,000.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Apache Radio Broadcasting Corporation to apply for a HUD Grant for Fiscal Year 1983 in order to complete facilities of the Radio station in the approximate amount of \$30,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on July 07, 1982 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
